Boundaries are not published and have no skier/ambassador services. If you ski/ride in wooded areas that are not designated trails, you are solely responsible for yourself. This means enter from and exit onto designated trails that are open to the public for skiing/riding. Failure to do so will result in the loss of your skiing/riding privileges. Wooded areas are recommended for expert skiers/riders, in groups of three or more. Do not ski/ride alone. Dashed-dotted lines used throughout.
